Education Qualifications:

A. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% of marks or an equivalent grade point under grading system at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject of concerned faculty.

B. Beside fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by UGC / CSIR / ICAR / similar test conducted by the State Government and should have published at least one article in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Science, New Delhi) rated journal.

However, the candidates who have acquired Ph.D. degree with course work as per the UGC Notification-2009 with two full length publications having NAAS rating not less than four, on the last date of submission of application will be exempted from NET requirement.

Note: Candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not be eligible for NET exemption.

C. Other Qualification:

Basic knowledge of computer application equivalent to course on computer concepts of Department of Electronic Accreditation of Computer course (DOEACC) Society or of the level as may be determined by the Govt. from time to time.

Other Relaxations:

A. NET / SLET / SET of similar test shall not be required for such subjects for which it is not conducted.

B. A relaxation of 5% at the Bachelor's and Master's Degree level shall be given to the SC/ST/PH category candidates.

C. Candidates from Veterinary Faculty will be exempted from NET for a period of 5 years from the date of appointment.

D. A relaxation of 5 % from 55 % to 50% of marks will be given to the Ph.D. degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.

Maximum Age Limit : Below 35 years but,

1. Age relaxable in suitable cases for Agricultural Universities employees of the Gujarat State.
2. Age relaxable in case of reserved categories candidates as per the prevalent rules of the State Government.
