## Invitation

*Dear colleagues,*

Livestock and dairying play a vital role in providing large self employment opportunities to millions of rural household's primarily small and marginal farmers and landless laborers in the country. Livestock provides subsidiary occupation to large section of the society particularly to the people living in rural areas and other remote areas where crop production on its own may not be engaging them fully. With the changing lifestyle and increasing awareness about the balanced diet, demand of food of animal origin is steadily increasing. In India, the demand of milk in 2020 is projected as 191.3 million tones. However, the growth rate in dairy sector including other livestock products is not enough to meet the challenge of future demand. Besides very low productivity, scarcity of feed and fodder, improper health and reproductive disorder of animals, poor infrastructure and lack of appropriate technologies, as well as climate change are becoming the major barriers in achieving required growth rate in livestock sector to fulfill the future demand. The present national seminar **"Livestock Breeding Strategies for Productivity Enhancement towards Rural Prosperity"** held during August 26-28, 2014 will provide suitable platform to our women scientists, teachers, personnel from development departments, NGOs, progressive farmers and farmer's representatives to deliberate on recent developments in the area of livestock production and management across the globe.

### VENUE

Anand is the administrative center of Anand district of Gujarat. Anand is popularly known as "Milk Capital of India". College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry is constituent faculty of Anand Agricultural University located in the outskirt of the city with 65 acres lush green campus. The college has witnessed 50 glorious years of its existence and 2014 is its Golden Jubilee Year. The veterinary college is conducting Under Graduate (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) and Post Graduate (M.V.Sc. & Ph.D.) programmes in almost all the subjects of Veterinary and Animal Science subjects with quality research. The alumni of this college have proved themselves successful professionals/ academicians as well as research workers in diverse field not only in India but also in USA, UK, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Pakistan, Korea etc. The college also conducts refresher courses/short term courses, technical sessions and extension activities at various stages from time to time in addition to seminars on current topics. The Veterinary College, Anand has been awarded consecutively for two years with "Best Veterinary College of the year" Award in 2013 by Times Research Pvt. Ltd. and

in 2014 by World Wide Achievers under India Education Excellence Award.

Reproductive Biology Research Unit (RBRU) established in 1958 is the pioneer institute in the research on reproduction in domestic and laboratory animals. It has implemented several project of State and Central Government for enhancing reproductive performance of farm animals. RBRU has Surti buffalo and Surti and Marwari goat farms. Several Schemes funded by ICAR, GOI, DBT, NIF, PL 480 have been successfully implemented by this department. The department has done commendable work on Embryo transfer and Endocrinology of Reproduction in farm animals through ICAR - NWP and AICRP project. Recently the department has completed scheme of "Socioeconomic development of rural women through reproductive biotechnology in Cattle and Buffaloes" funded by DBT, GOI. Additionally, Centrally sponsored scheme on "Conservation and Development of Surti goats" was completed successfully in 2013. Gujarat Co-operative Milk Marketing Federation (GCMMF) is funding a Scheme since 2006 "*Mahila Pashupalan Talim Yojana*". More than 4000 rural women have been trained in 162 residential programmes of one week. The transfer of technology is now evident as many trainee women are expanding the existing livestock farms and improving their livelihood opportunities by dairy farming.

Indian Association of Women veterinarians (IAWV) was established on October 2, 1985. More than 450 Women Veterinarians have enrolled as its life members and are many state chapters working actively. It is very aptly decided by the President Dr. Madhu Swamy and General Secretary Dr. Rajeswari.R to hold the XIII National Technical Conference of IAWV at Anand, during Golden Jubilee celebration year of the college.

### WEATHER

Only one abstract is allowed for each presenting author. There is no limit on the number of abstracts to be submitted as co-author (non-presenting author). The presenting author must register for the seminar latest by 05<sup>th</sup> August 2014: otherwise the abstract will not be published in the proceedings. All the abstracts should be submitted strictly by email (iawv014@gmail.com). The last date for receiving abstract is 05<sup>th</sup> August, 2014.

The authors should adopt the following criteria for writing their abstracts.

- ❖ **Font:** Times New Roman
- ❖ **Font size:** 12 except Title (14)
- ❖ **Title & Authors:** Bold & Capital letter
- ❖ **Address and Email:** Sentence case without bold
- ❖ **Abstract Proper:** Sentence case with 1.15 line spacing
- ❖ **Page setup:** Portrait, A4 size with margin of 1 inch on each side
- ❖ **Word limit:** Maximum 300 words including title

**Note:** Publication committee will reserve the right to change the format of abstract if needed.

**Oral presentation:** Due to time constraint only few selected abstracts will be allowed for oral presentation in each session. Facilities for power point presentations will be provided to the presenting author. A maximum of 10 minutes will be allotted for a presentation (8 minutes)
