Simultaneously, Camel meat is also healthier as they produce carcasses with less cholesterol than other meat animals. Camel is better as riding animal than horse and can carry more weight. Camel is resistant to many notorious diseases like foot and mouth disease, mad cow disease (BSE) and Brucellosis etc. India is having 0.52 million nos. of camel which is about 2.5% of total world camel population. Highest camel population is in Rajasthan followed by Haryana and Gujarat. In view of this a one day state level seminar is being organized which will cover the important themes like draftability, behavior and welfare, health care management, milk, meat, hair productivity enhancement, marketing of milk, meat, hairs and their by-products, feed, fodder and nutrient requirements of camel.
