



"Plastic Free Campus Awareness Drive Organized by CAET, AAU, Godhra"



India is set to impose a nation-wide ban on single-use plastic (including plastic bags, straws, cups, plates, small bottles and certain types of sachets) on October 2, 2019. India generates about 9.4 million tonnes of plastic waste each year and with no effective disposal method, the plastic waste ends up the roadsides, in landfills and water bodies.

To make CAET campus plastic free, a special 'Plastic Free Campus Awareness Drive' was organized on occasion of Gandhi Jayanti (02/10/2021) under the head of 'Azadi ka Amrut Mahotdav' and 'Clean India Movement'. 70 students of second and third year of B.
