Celebration World Environment Day



B. A. College of Agriculture celebrated "World Environment Day" on 5 June 2024 with great enthusiasm, reinforcing its commitment to environmental sustainability and raising awareness about pressing ecological issues. Shukla, the Principal and Dean of the college, resonated deeply with this year's theme, 'Land Restoration, Desertification and Drought Resilience' during his interaction with the faculty members, NSS volunteers, and NCC cadets. He emphasized the critical role of agriculture in environmental conservation and the responsibility of future agriculture professionals to spearhead sustainable initiatives. The college also organized a tree-planting drive on the campus ground. Students, faculty, and staff enthusiastically participated in planting several saplings of the native species. This initiative aimed to enhance the campus greenery and foster a sense of environmental stewardship among the students. This program was coordinated by Dr. Sahdev Luhar, NSS Programme Officer; Dr. Rucha Dave, NCC Officer (Girls); and Dr. A. K. Maru, NCC Officers (Boys).

It aimed to improve response time, boost confidence in handling emergencies, and increase survival rates by maintaining blood circulation and oxygen flow until professional medical help arrives.

B. A. College of Agriculture, AAU, Anand, organized a seven-day Special NSS Camp at Kankapura village of Borsad taluka in Anand district from 22/02/2025 to 28/02/2025. Total 123 NSS volunteers participated in this residential camp and carried out activities like base line survey of the village, village cleaning, rally and street drama on different social issues like health and cleanliness, voter's awareness, natural farming, women empowerment, self-defence training, save water, save food, environment protection, *betibachao-betipadhao, no tobacco - no liquor* etc., guests lectures on different topics and wall slogan writing.
