



“THALASSEMIA TESTING PROGRAMME” AT COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE & POLYTECHNIC IN AGRICULTURE, VASO

A Thalassemia Testing and Awareness Programme was successfully conducted at college of Vaso & Polytechnic College of Agriculture on 02.12.2025 with the aim of educating students about genetic disorders and promoting early screening for better health management. The programme was organized by the College in collaboration with Red Cross Society. The event commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Hemlata Saini, NSS Programme Officer and event coordinator, who emphasized the importance of this test for society. This programme is chaired by Dr. B. C. Patel, Principal, who given his remarkable speech on its importance. More than 105 students participated in the camp and voluntarily underwent thalassemia screening tests, including CBC and Hemoglobin Electrophoresis.

During the event, medical professionals briefed students about the importance of thalassemia testing, explaining that thalassemia is a hereditary blood disorder that can be prevented through timely screening, especially before marriage and during pregnancy. Experts highlighted that carriers of thalassemia may not show symptoms but can pass the disorder to the next generation, making awareness and testing crucial. Faculty members appreciated the initiative and encouraged students to take responsibility for their health. The event concluded with a vote of thanks to the medical team and organizing committee.
