Educational Visit to College of Agriculture, Jabugam

An educational Visit was organized for the students of Shri Javahar Ashram Shala on 06 February 2026 to the Agriculture Research Station and College of Agriculture, Jabugam, under Anand Agricultural University. The main objective of this visit was to provide practical exposure and create awareness among students about agricultural research, modern farming practices and agricultural education.

The visit started morning at the Agriculture Research Station, Jabugam. The students were guided by Dr. Sanjay Makwana, Assistant Research Scientist, who explained various research activities carried out at the station. He introduced students to different varieties of crops, especially mango and banana and demonstrated field-level research work. Students were also informed about natural farming practices, crop management techniques and other ongoing agricultural experiments. The session was very informative and helped students understand the importance of research in agriculture. Dr. Deep M. Patel, Assistant Professor, provided detailed information about the college, agricultural education and career opportunities in the field of agriculture. He explained the role of agriculture in national development and motivated students to consider agriculture as a future career. After the introductory session, students visited various laboratories of the college. In the Soil Science and Agricultural Chemistry Laboratory, they observed different instruments such as pH meter, EC meter, distillation unit, flame photometer, spectrophotometer, and different types of rock and soil samples. The students also visited the Entomology Laboratory, where they learned about different insects, followed by visits to the Horticulture, Pathology, and Genetics Laboratories. Students were highly impressed and surprised to see the advanced instruments and practical learning facilities available in the college.

The students actively participated, showed keen interest and expressed happiness after visiting each laboratory and farm. The entire program was conducted smoothly under the guidance of Dr. J. B. Patel, Principal and Unit Head, College of Agriculture, Anand Agricultural University, Jabugam. The students and teachers of Shri Javahar Ashram Shala express their feedback and told that this type of visit proved to be a memorable and enriching learning experience for all the students.
