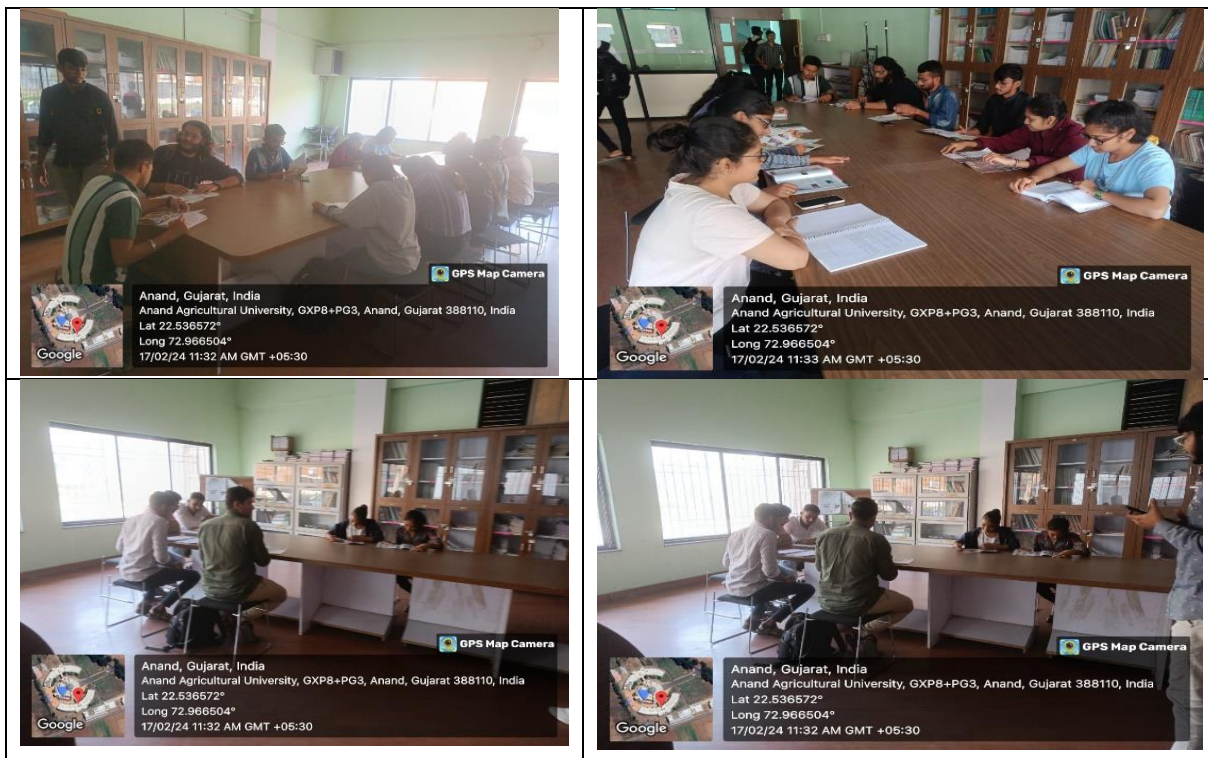


Debate on ‘Yog ka aadhar prakrutik ahaar’

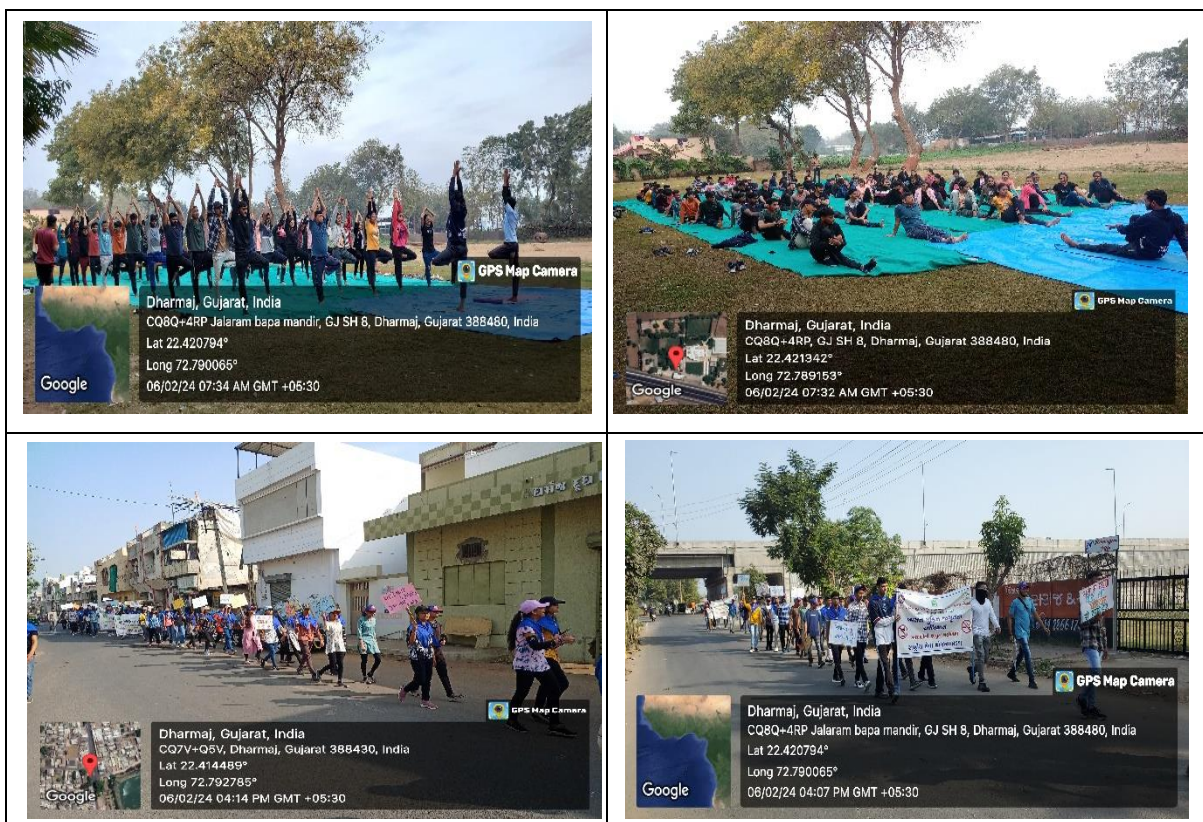


Rally and Cleanliness Drive

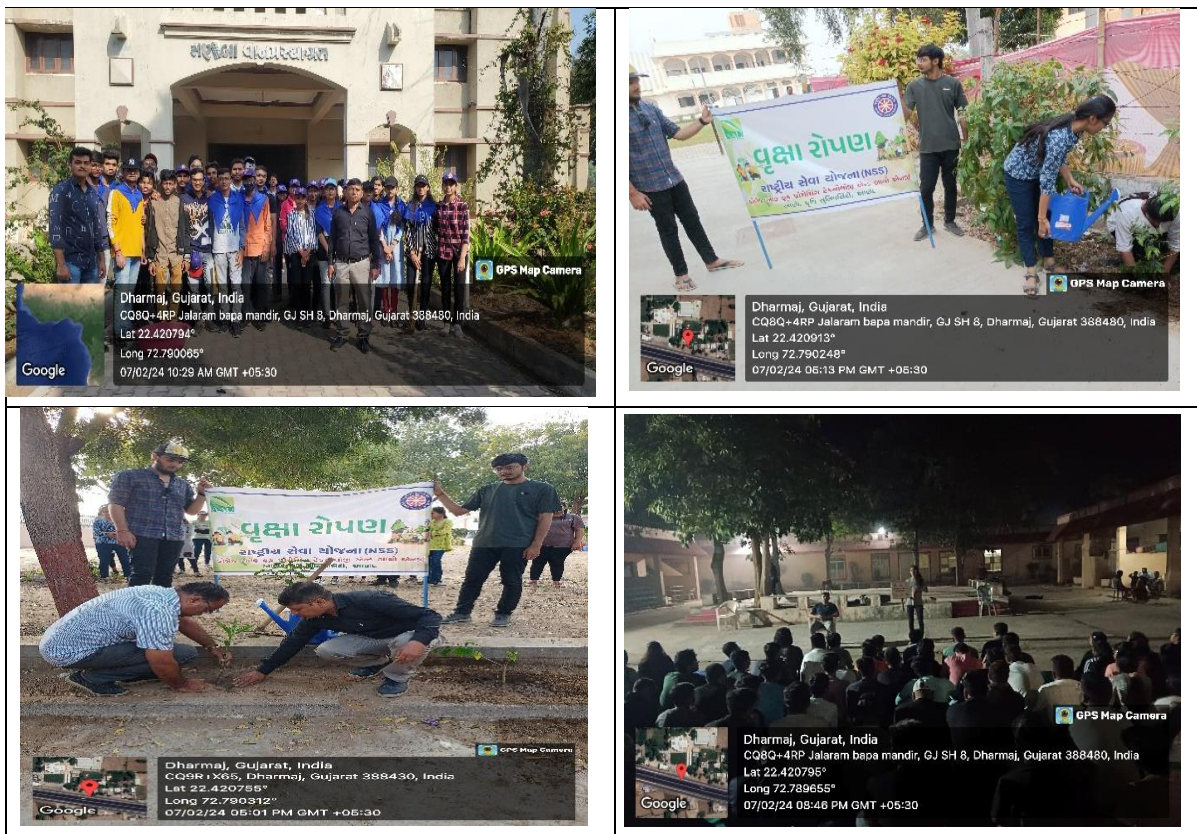


Fit India, Poster preparation, Rally on Nashamukti and Survey of Village

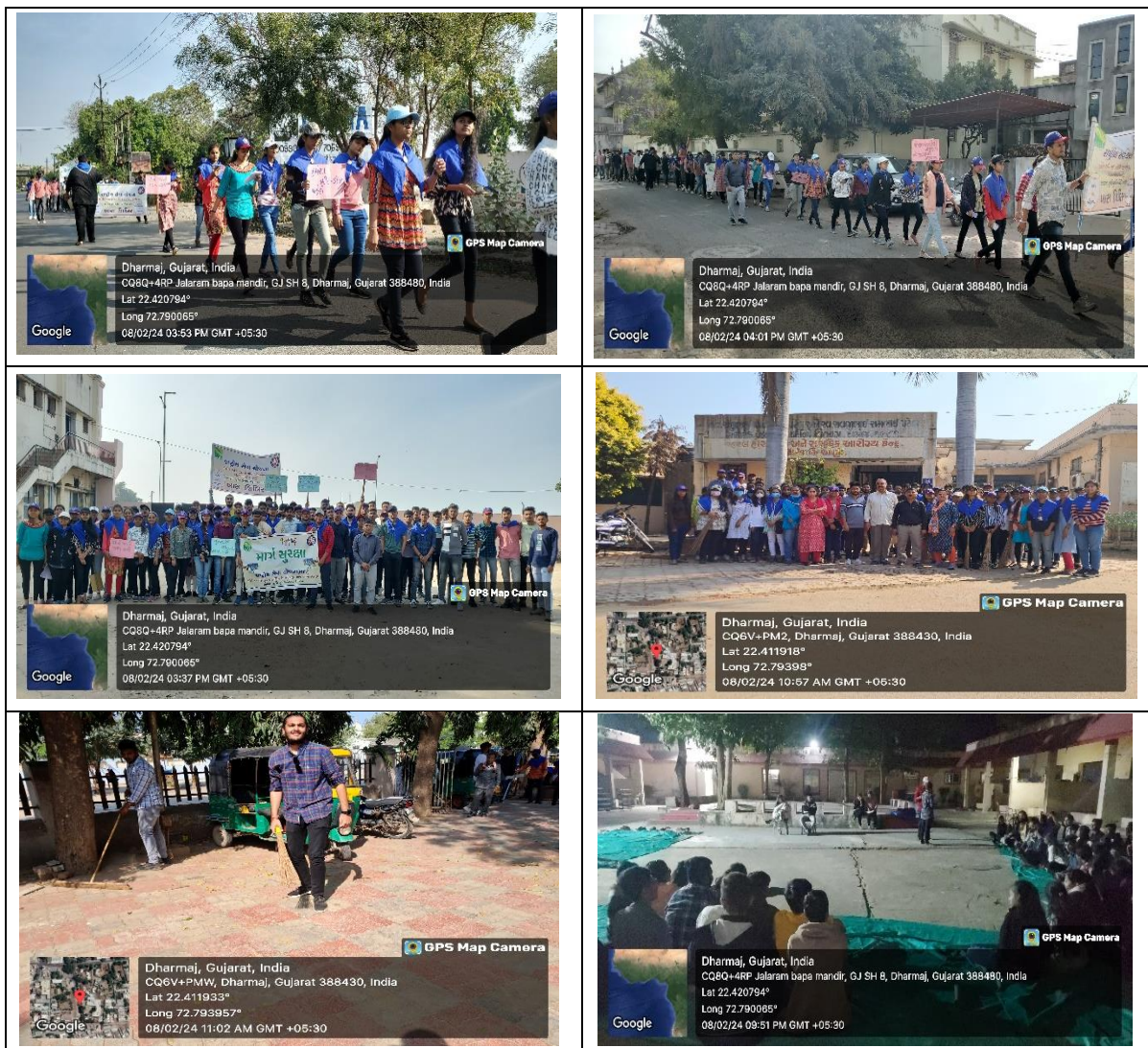




Visit to Old Age Home and Tree Plantation

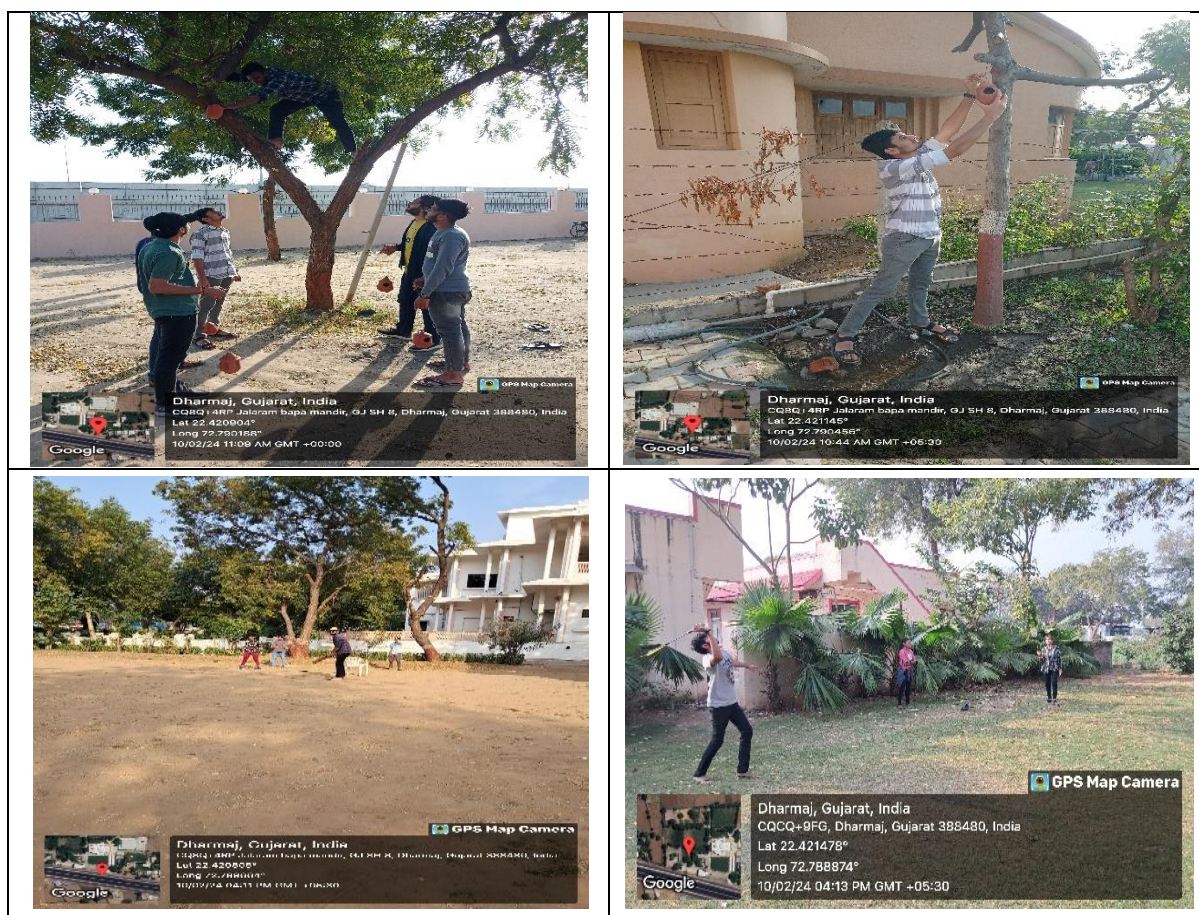
