

Students from College of Agriculture, Amreli visited Main Vegetable Research Station AAU, Anand

A visit to the Main Vegetable Research Station, Anand Agricultural University, Anand, was made by sixty-five students of the fifth semester from the College of Agriculture, Junagadh Agricultural University, Amreli, on October 24th, 2024. The purpose of the visit was to give students an in-depth academic understanding of the research conducted on vegetable crops at the station. Dr. R. R. Acharya, Research Scientist (Vegetables), discussed the importance of vegetables in daily nutrition, the existing scenario of vegetables in agriculture, and provided insights into ongoing research at the station.
